

Educator Library Card

The educator card allows its holder to supplement their curriculum with expanded access to public library resources for children and teens.

Who is eligible?

Public and private K-12 **school librarians, teachers, and homeschoolers** who work in Delaware, including those whose residence is out-of-state.

Benefits

- Multiple copy request service (at participating libraries)
- Borrow & request up to 99 items
- Extended loan periods

Limits

- Excludes walk-in collections and Interlibrary Loan services (ILL)
- Overdue items must be returned before any other materials may be checked out.
- The educator card is intended for educational purposes and items checked out on this card should be for professional use.
- Materials for personal use are to be checked out separately on a personal account.
- A personal account is not required to obtain an educator card.
- Educators are personally responsible for all materials checked out, including lost or damaged items.
- If you have fees on your personal account, you must take care of them before applying for an educator card.

- Ask for information at any service desk
- Library staff will provide an application, and employment verification form
- Make an appointment with the educator card program liaison at your library to review guidelines, turn in required paperwork, and obtain a card.
