Notice is hereby given that New Castle County is proposing a Substantial Amendment (SA) to its 2019 Annual Action Plan to allocate CDBG-CV and ESG-CV funds awarded under the FY20 CARES Act supplemental funding legislation. The County expects to receive an additional \$2,476,428 in CDBG-CV funds and \$1,582,960 in ESG-CV funds.

The purpose of the public hearing is to discuss the County's intent to allocate funds for activities for income-eligible households that have been directly impacted by Covid-19, including:

- (1) Providing \$795,285.60 in CDBG-CV funds for Hotel/Motel Vouchers
- (2) Providing \$60,000 in CDBG-CV funds for Health-Related Supportive Services
- (3) Providing \$1,328,428.61 in CDBG-CV funds for Homeless/AIDS Operations

- (4) Providing \$30,000 in ESG-CV funds for Homeless Management Information System (HMIS)
- (5) Providing \$100,000 in ESG-CV funds for Street Outreach
- (6) Providing \$711,480 in ESG-CV funds for Emergency Shelter Operations
- (7) Providing \$583,184 in ESG-CV funds for Rapid Re-Housing
- (8) Providing \$158,296 in ESG-CV funds for Program Administration

The City of Newark intends to allocate funds for activities for income-eligible households that have been directly impacted by Covid-19, including:

- (1) Providing \$40,000 in CDBG-CV funds for Hotel/Motel Vouchers
- (2) Providing \$222,713.79 in CDBG-CV funds for Homeless/AIDS Operations
- (3) Providing \$30,000 in CDBG-CV funds for Health-Related Supportive Services

The County will present the Draft SA to the New Castle County Commission on December 22, 2020 for action. The County intends to submit the approved SA to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on or about December 30, 2020.
