DIVISION CLASSES

Classes begin promptly at 9:00 am

Leadline – Open to all riders who cannot ride on their own. All riders will be on-line.

1. Walk
2. Walk/Trot
3. Trot Over 2 Poles

Walk/Trot (Beg OR AdvBeg) – For riders in their 1st year of showing. Riders may not enter a canter class at this show.

4. Walk
5. Walk/Trot
6. Trot Over 4 Poles

Walk/Trot/Canter – Open to riders who are not jumping at this show.

7. Walk/Trot
8. Walk/Trot/Canter on your own
9. Walk/Trot/Canter as a group

Beginner Equitation – Open to riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Riders are being judged. No penalty for trotting fences.

10. Walk/Trot
11. Walk/Trot/Canter
12. 18" cross rails

Horse & Rider Combo – Open to horse/rider combinations not jumping over 2' at this show. Riders are judged 50% on mount, 50% on rider. No penalty for trotting fences.

15. Over Fences – 2' cross rails

SCHOOLING SESSION FOR AFTERNOON RIDERS

Baby Green Hunter Horse/Pony – Open to horses or ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Mounts are being judged. No penalty for trotting fences.

Pleasure Horse/Pony

HORSE SHOW RULES:

1. You **MUST** submit your completed registration form (including Coggins Accession # and proof of Flu/Rhino) and payment in full by the stated deadline to be registered in the show.
2. The morning schooling session will be held from 7:30 - 8:45 AM and is **open ONLY to riders in the morning classes**. Sessions will be available in 10-minute increments and limited to no more than 5 riders at a time.
3. **Schooling for afternoon classes will be available after the Horse & Rider Combo Division ONLY.**
4. Additional schooling jumps will be available in the indoor arena (if not in use for the show).
5. A rider's age is the age as of January 1, 2021.
6. The show starts promptly at 9 AM.
7. Classes may be divided, combined, canceled, or re-ordered if conditions warrant.
8. Western riders may enter English classes.
9. When mounted, all riders must wear ASTM/SEI certified helmets with harnesses and boots with a 1/2" heel. Dress code is show attire or polo and breeches. Half chaps are acceptable.
10. Fence heights are approximate.
11. Points are awarded 6-5-4-3-2-1, each class will be awarded 6 ribbons. A division Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded.
12. Judges' decisions are final.
13. All dogs must be leashed (although we would prefer that they stay home).
14. New Castle County, Carousel Park, and show management are not responsible for any damage, injury, or loss to persons, animals, vehicles, or property of any exhibitor or spectator on or off the show grounds.

COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS

- Masks are required for those indoors who are not fully vaccinated and unable to social distance.
- We recommend that spectators bring their own chairs

Pre-entry must include a completed registration form, payment, your negative Coggins accession number, and proof of Flu/Rhino vaccine (within 1 year).
