### Construction General Permit Signage Guidelines & Recommendations

The Delaware Construction General Permit includes a requirement to post notice of permit coverage. To help illustrate this requirement, the specifications for that posting are summarized below and can also be found at this [link](#).

#### Requirement to post a Notice of Permit Coverage:

- Must be posted at a safe, publicly accessible location in close proximity to the construction site.
- Must be visible from the public road nearest the active part of the construction site.
- Must use a font large enough to be readily viewed from a public right-of-way.
- Recommended sign dimensions should be 2' x 2' or 2' x 3' depending on how information is presented, with a minimum font size of at least 1 inch (Font size will vary depending on distance from right-of-way).

#### At a minimum, the notice must include the following information:

- The NOI number.
- Contact name and phone number to obtain additional construction site information.
- Contact name and phone number to obtain a copy of the Approved Plan.
- The following statement "If you observe indicators of stormwater pollutants in the discharge or in the receiving waterbody, call the DNREC's Spill Notification 24 HR Hotline at 1-800-662-8802."
