Reminders To All Teams

Line-up cards (with **legible** player names and uniform numbers) are required before each game.

Uniform penalties will be enforced (effective date TBD). Players who fail to meet the uniform requirement will not be permitted to play.

Site Coordinators will be reminding teams that they are responsible for removing all trash from their team areas at the conclusion of the game. Please help keep these areas clean.

Referee payment: 40-minute halves = \$45/team

NOTE: **Mondays through Thursday evenings** may be used as make-up dates (if Banning becomes available). Every effort will be made to notify teams in writing at least one week in advance of all rescheduled games. Managers should stay in contact with the league coordinator for rescheduling information.

If a team has not submitted a line-up card and payment to the referee by the time the 5 minute grace period has elapsed, the game clock will start and the opposing manager has the option of accepting a forfeit.

Each player is required to carry a photo ID to all games. Failure to positively ID any player when requested by an opposing manager will result in the game being declared a forfeit (player may be positively identified by coordinator or officials).

Reminder to all teams: there is a **ZERO TOLERANCE** policy in effect in all New Castle County Sports programs. Offenders will be penalized accordingly.

Rule X.K. - Zero Tolerance Policy: The New Castle County Sports and Athletics Office is unwilling to accept any form of profane language, disrespectful behavior or unsportsmanlike conduct by players, coaches, officials, spectators or staff members.

1. The mission of the Department of Community Services is to provide a wide range of services to New Castle County residents and visitors that will strengthen families and individuals, build social capital, improve neighborhoods, and ensure places and spaces to live, learn, play, socialize, and recreate. Realizing that diversity and inclusion makes us stronger, the Department embraces diversity and inclusion in all programs by encouraging participation of individuals of all ethnicities, gender, religious beliefs, sexual orientation, age, ability or disability.
2. In order to ensure that we provide a culture where individuals feel safe, respected and treated fairly, the Sports Office will investigate reported incidences of violations of this policy, issuing appropriate sanctions as necessary.
 - a. Any individual may report an incident involving a violation of this policy by completing an Incident Report Form that is available on our website: www.nccdesports.com and clicking on Submit and Incident Report. All reports will remain confidential.
 - b. Baiting, taunting and trash talking between players will be penalized in accordance with sport specific rules. Repeat offenses in the same contest will result in removal and suspension.
 - c. Verbal abuse of officials or staff will result in removal and suspension from future contests as outlined in the Table of Violations and Recommended Penalties.
 - d. Any player, coach, official or spectator observed making comments that are intended to intimidate or demean another individual based on race, ethnicity/nationality, gender, religious belief, sexual orientation, age, ability or disability will be removed from the contest and required to leave the facility. Additional sanctions will be issued after investigation, up to or including a long-term suspension from New Castle County programs.

It is the intent of the Sports Office to aggressively discourage participants from arguing with officials by issuing strong sanctions and removing problem participants from the league.
